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### **2010 Rules and Regulations** *(please keep a copy of this page for your records)*

1. All applicants must submit 3 images of your work and one of your booth (a website, email or CD are acceptable). Hard copy submissions will not be returned.
2. Artists may share a booth, but images of work and names of all participants must be included with the initial application.
3. All work exhibited must be original and handcrafted by the artist. The limited use of manufactured with items will be allowed, only if incidental to the final product. The artist or their representative must be present with their work for the entire event. No buy/sell or flea market merchandise is allowed.
4. Booth fee is \$75.00 for a 10' by 10' booth or \$90.00 for a 10' by 10' corner booth if available. There are limited quantities of corner booths. Electricity is \$20.00 and a 20 foot outdoor quality extension cord must be provided by the artist. Checks are payable to SDMA and must accompany the application. Checks will be cashed as artists are accepted by the jury.
5. Artists will be notified by email or letter as to their status after jurying.
6. There will be no refunds after June 1, 2010. Cancellations after this date are non-refundable. NO refunds will be given due to cancellation of the event by, an act of god, local authorities, or a weather related incident.
7. All artists are expected to handle State of Michigan Sale tax appropriately. A concessionaire's form will be provided in the artist's welcome packet.
8. Artists are responsible for providing their own tent, tables, chairs and any display materials.
9. A security guard will be on site overnight Friday, however, artists are responsible for insurance and protection of their property as stated on page one of the application
10. All inventory, storage boxes, artwork, etc must be contained within the booth space and may not be stored on the sidewalk, lawn, etc.
11. Any audio or visual effects (music, flashing lights, etc) must be contained within the artist's booth so as to not interfere with adjacent booths.
12. Artists may unload at their booth site and reserved parking is provided within 1/2 block of the event.
13. Indoor bathrooms are provided for the artists.
14. A continental breakfast and afternoon snack are provided along with water throughout the event.
15. The Summerfest Craft & Art Show is sponsored by the Saline Downtown Merchants Association and is part of a larger event. Please visit [www.salinesummerfest.org](http://www.salinesummerfest.org) to see all of the activities.
16. Exhibitors agree to conduct themselves in a respectful, co-operative manner. Summerfest is a family friendly event and does not wish to include radical, disturbing displays or outbursts of any kind.
17. Violation to comply with any of these rules will result in immediate expulsion.
